Arrival:
The island of Krk is connected to the main land with a bridge, thus being easily accessible by car.. Buses from Rijeka and Zagreb leave frequently to Krk. From many European cities there are also inexpensive night bus lines to Rijeka and even directly to Malinska .The island has its own airport (officially the airport of Rijeka); and there are many charter flights and regular lines.
